Life Sketch of St. Joseph

ST. Joseph was a humble carpenter and was considered as a righteous man. Everything we know about ST. Joseph, the husband of Mary the foster father of Jesus, comes from the Bible.

After marrying Mary, Joseph found that she was already Pregnant and being "A just man and unwilling to put her to shame he decided to divorce her quietly, knowing that if he did so Publicly, She could be Stoned to death. An angel however, came to Joseph and told him that the Child Mary Carried was the Son of God and was Conceived by the Holy Spirit So Joseph accepted Mary as his wife Mary writhed in Labour Pain. School Regulations

A General Discipline

1. Students Should arrive at the School at least 15 minutes before the assembly. Soon after the assembly bell, the School gate will be locked and the latecomers will be asked to go home at the risk of the Parents/guardians.
2. Every student should bring with him/her daily, the School diary.
3. All are expected to attend the class on the last and Opening day after each Vacation. Those who are absent without prior information will be fined. Those who are absent because of Sickness must inform the School before or the reopening day failing which they must pay the Penalty.

- All leave must be applied for in writing to the Principal briefly.
- Any damage done will be made good by the one who does it.
- Pupils are responsible to the School authorities not only for their conduct in the School but also their general behavior outside.
- No pupil may leave the School Premises without the permission of the principal during the School hours.
- Students are responsible for the Custody of their book and belonging. The School will not be responsible for any loss or damage done to them.
- Parents and guardians are not allowed to see their children or interview Teacher during School hours without the Permission of the Principal.
- No gifts to the members of the Staff will be allowed without the Permission of the Principal.
- All are expected to Speak English in the School Premises.
- No Pupil will be Promoted to the next Class before the end of the School Year.
- All Children are expected to bring the Tiffin & Fast food items/Junk food are Strictly forbidden in the School.

Examination and Norms for Promotion

- There will be Three Term Examination.
- Children absent from an examination for any reason will not re-examined.
- The evaluation of the answer paper falls under the jurisdiction of the Principal.
- All the answer sheets of Assessment be shown to the Parents.
- 90% attendance will be necessary for a Student for Promotion to the next Class.
- Students must appear the dew tests conducted by the School.

Payment of Fees

- Fees are charged for 12 months for all classes. Fees for the months of May and June must be paid in May and March to be Paid in February.
- No Cheque is promoted.
- Any student whose fees are in arrears will not be allowed to sit for the examination. No transfer certificate or no other document will be issued until the arrears are cleared.
- St. Joseph's high School is not an aided School and fees are its only income. While unnecessary Charges will not made in the fees, the governing body of the institution reserves the right to enhance the fees in accordance with the cost of maintenance.
- A late fine Rs. 10- will be levied from every Student if the fees is Paid after the 15th of every month.

Withdrawal / Dismissal

- Before withdrawing a Student from the School, a month's notice is to be given or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
- No leaving Certificates will be issued unless requested in writing by the Parent and the dues are Cleared Writing by the Parent and the dues are cleared.
- Immorality grave insubordination, Contempt to authority or willful damage to School Property is always a sufficient reason for dismissal.
- A student who uses unfair means or give assistance in any form during examination will be dismissed.
- The School reserves to itself the right to dismiss Students whose diligence or progress in Studies is Steadily unsatisfactory or whose guardians Show little interest in the Progress of their wards.
- After taking new admission in Class, if a Pupil is absent for 10 Continuous days, the name will be Struck off the rolls.

7. Forbidden practices like Smoking, use of drugs or intoxicants, rude behavior, Contempt to authority, and Communalism may Cause immediate dismissal.
8. Bringing cameras, Cellular phones or any such electronic devices is strictly forbidden and violation of this may cause immediate dismissal.
9. Buying and eating from vendors or from shops when children are destined for School is Strictly forbidden to the Students.

Library Rules

1. All Students of Std. III to X may borrow books from the library.
2. Strict silence shall be observed in the library and the reading room.
3. Each pupil is entitled to take out on loan one book at a time and keep the same for 10 days. Dictionaries, guides and other costly reference books shall not be lent out.
4. Student, who keep book longer than the time Permitted, will be fined one rupee per day.
5. The attention of the Principal/librarian should be drawn to damage of books borrowed.
6. Issue of books may at anytime be suspended by order of the Principal.
7. All book taken from the library should be returned two weeks before the examination.
